

# Youth Identification Procedures

Safety Information for Parents/Guardians at the Canad Inns Stadium



## **Why do the Winnipeg Blue Bombers use identification stickers?**

In case a child has become separated from their parent or guardian the sticker will help our staff locate where their adults are sitting.

## **Who needs to wear the identification sticker?**

All children ages 11 and under will be provided with a sticker for safety purposes. We appreciate your cooperation in assuring that these are worn at all time through the remainder of the event.

## **What does the sticker mean?**

The sticker identifies the children's Section, Row and Seat number. If the child becomes separated from their parent our event or security staff will follow the proper information in order to bring your child back to your seat location.

## **Who gives out the stickers?**

Our trained Flight Crew will be at the entrances of all the gates upon the opening of the stadium until the end of the 1st Quarter in order to ensure that all children under the age of 11 have been provided with an identification sticker.

## **What if I go looking for my child?**

If you are not at your seat when the child is brought back the staff will then proceed to the Guest Services Desk in the Lower Concourse or the East and West Sides and your seat location will be called over the General PA system so you and your child can be reunited.

## **Where do I get a replacement sticker?**

If you have lost your child's identification sticker you can find a replacement sticker at the Guest Services Desk in the Lower Concourse of the East and West Sides.
